

# Lakeview Sanitary Lift Station replacement

### August 2021

#### Upcoming work in your community

We are installing new sanitary lines and manholes to connect the new Lakeview Sanitary Lift Station to the existing sewer infrastructure.

Work is expected to begin Sept. 13, 2021 and will take approximately three weeks to complete.

#### **Construction impacts**

- The east entrance to North Glenmore Park will be closed. Park users will be detoured along 66 Avenue S.W. to the west entrance which is located off 37 Street S.W.
- A section of the Glenmore Pathway adjacent to the construction area will be closed. The detour will be via the gravel trail west of North Glenmore Park Road S.W.
- Temporary 24-hour sanitary bypass pumping systems will be operating at the two manhole locations (map on page two). This will ensure sanitary service is maintained during construction. A sound enclosure will be in place to reduce the impact to the surrounding area.
- Increased construction related traffic and noise.

#### Background

When water runs down a sink, drain or toilet, it becomes wastewater. Calgary has a system just for wastewater, moving it by gravity and pumps to one of three wastewater treatment plants. Portions of the communities of Lakeview and North Glenmore Park rely on the Lakeview Sanitary Lift Station to transfer wastewater from its catchment area to the sewer trunk.

The existing lift station no longer meets current operational and safety guidelines. We are constructing a new lift station to ensure we continue to provide a high-level of sanitary service to your community.

The new lift station will be located in the northeast corner of North Glenmore Park, alongside the North Glenmore Park Road (map on page two).

Construction of the new lift station started in December 2020 and will take 12-18 months to complete.

#### Work during the COVID-19 pandemic

The City of Calgary continues to treat, test and deliver high-quality water to Calgarians during the COVID-19 pandemic. While we prioritize the delivery of essential services, our capital construction programs are moving forward where possible. These projects are critical to supporting current and future development. We are working closely with our partners and will continue to monitor the current situation, making adjustments as needed.

Our most important priority remains the health, safety and well-being of our staff and contractors. We continue to put in place new measures and protocols to ensure public health is protected.
