



Access Road Construction and Median Removal on 114 Avenue

Notice Date: July 24, 2025

Beginning July 24, construction crews will begin preparation and mobilization to their construction office site, east of Barlow Trail S.E. and south of 114 Avenue. Crews will remove the existing medians in 114 Avenue west of Barlow Trail and begin construction of the temporary access road along the project alignment, in the green space north of the properties. Work will begin as early as July 28.

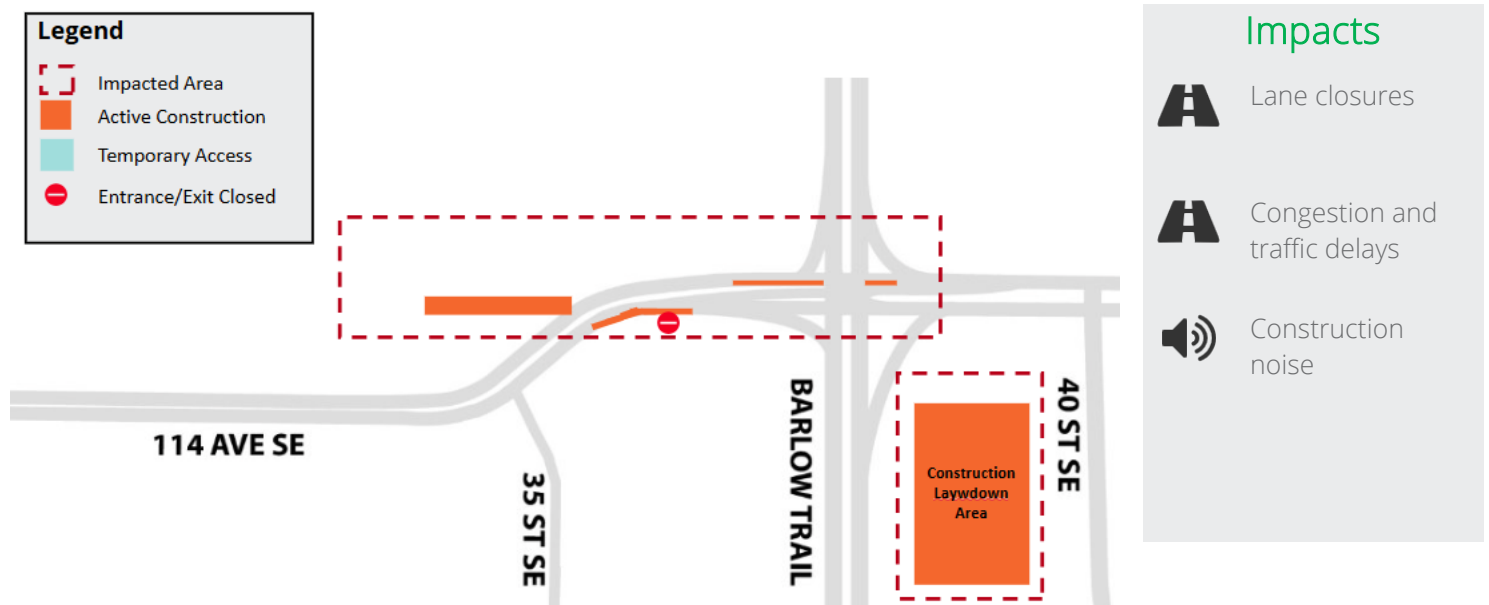

What is the work? Green Line Construction – 114 Avenue and Barlow Trail S.E. Roadworks

This is a phased project that will have several construction setups. The first phase will reduce 114 Avenue to one lane east and westbound at points near the intersection with Barlow Trail S.E. Where possible, future phases will maintain as many travel lanes as possible. Future construction notices will be issued to communicate subsequent phases.

About Green Line LRT – SE Project

The SE Segment, from Shepard in the southeast to the Event Centre/Grand Central Station in the Beltline, will build the first 16 kilometres of an overall 46-kilometre vision, before connecting with the future Downtown Segment and into the existing Red and Blue LRT Lines. Including the Downtown Segment, Phase 1 will build, 17.2 kilometres of twin-track LRT infrastructure, 12 new stations, a maintenance and storage facility, three Park and Ride lots, and 28 new modern low-floor light rail vehicles.
