On December 6, 2023, a closure of 6 Street S.E. will be set in place to accommodate the City of Calgary utility relocation work. At this point, the intersection of 6 Street S.E. and 12 Avenue will reopen to allow for two-way traffic on 12 Avenue.

What is the work? City of Calgary Utility Relocation – 6 Street S.E. between 11 and 12 Avenue

- Closure of 6 Street S.E. between 11 and 12 Avenue.
- 6 Street S.E. and 12 Avenue intersection to reopen.
- Two-way traffic allowed on 12 Avenue east of 3 Street S.E.
- Detour in place for 12 Avenue cycle track at 3 Street S.E. for duration of Beltline Downtown Utility Relocation Project.
- Two-way traffic on 11 Avenue between 3 Street S.E. and Olympic Way/4 Street S.E. Local access only. No thru traffic.
- Access to Ramsay via 6 Street S.E. and 12 Avenue. Follow detours.

About Green Line LRT

The Green Line is Calgary's next light rail transit (LRT) line. With \$5.5 billion in commitments from the Government of Canada, Government of Alberta and City of Calgary, it is the largest infrastructure investment in our city's history.

The current work in Beltline and Downtown is part of the utility relocation program required to make way for Phase 1 construction from Shepard to Eau Claire.
