

What is the work? ATCO Utility Relocation - Centre Street ,11 Avenue, 12 Avenue

Work is expected to begin Monday, January 8 and will be active for approximately two weeks. Sidewalk, and parking and traffic lane closures will be required on Centre Street between 11 and 12 Avenue; as well as the two north lanes of 11 Avenue; and the north lane and cycle track on 12 Avenue.

Pedestrian detours. Sidewalk closures.

- Cycle track detours.
- No on-street parking.
- Lane closures.
- Access to parkades maintained.

The Green Line is Calgary's next light rail transit (LRT) line. With \$5.5 billion in commitments from the Government of Canada, Government of Alberta and City of Calgary, it is the largest infrastructure investment in our city's history.

The current work in Beltline and Downtown is part of the utility relocation program required to make way for Phase 1 construction from Shepard to Eau Claire.
