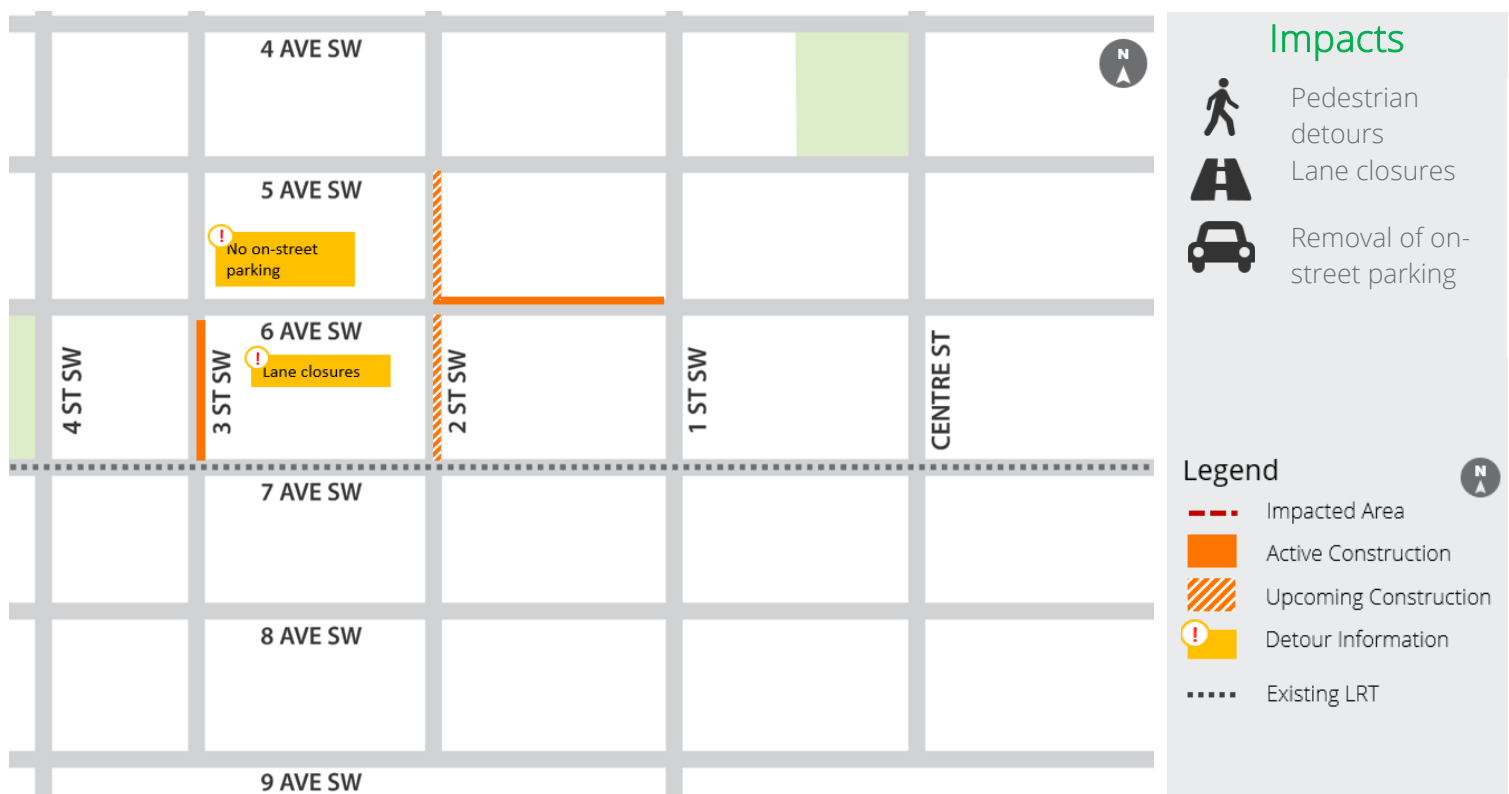

What is the work? Bell/Zayo Utility Relocation – 6 Avenue, 3 Street S.W.

Bell/Zayo will be working on the relocation of their infrastructure. Construction activity will begin on the north two lanes of 6 Avenue and on 3 Street S.W., and will continue on 2 Street S.W.

- Lane closures on 3 Street S.W. between 6 and 7 Avenue.
- Lane closure on the north two lanes of 6 Avenue between 1 and 2 Street S.W.
- Lane closures on 2 Street S.W. between 6 and 7 Avenue.
- No on-street parking.
