



## Please Read – Temporary On-Street Parking Restrictions and 9 Street S.E. Laneway Access Restriction

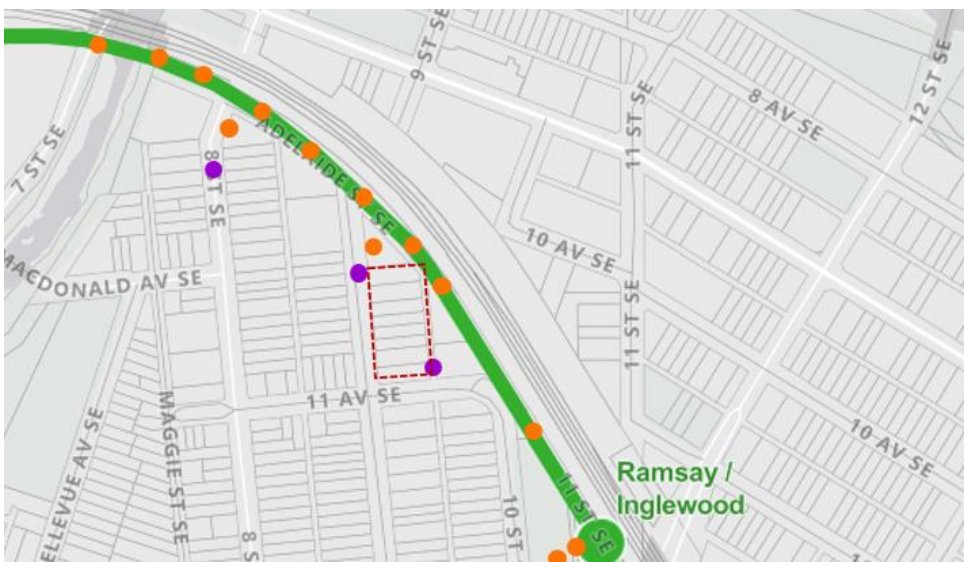
Due to upcoming geotechnical borehole ground investigations planned for late June/early July, your property has been identified as being impacted by temporary on-street parking and/or a laneway access restriction. Temporary on-street parking restrictions near each test location and access to the laneway behind 9 Street S.E. will be limited for **about one day, between 9am and 3pm**. Traffic Signage will be posted to inform you of restrictions. For the laneway access restriction, regular City Waste & Recycling services will not be impacted.

### 8 Street S.E., north of MacDonald Avenue






On-street parking will be temporarily removed during construction. Vehicle access to the River's Edge apartments will remain open.

### 9 Street S.E., north of 11 Avenue

On-street parking will be removed during construction. Laneway access for properties on the east side of 9 Street S.E., north of 11 Avenue, will also be restricted but not blocked. Residential parking zones on 11 Avenue and 9 Street S.E. will not be enforced by Calgary Parking during these days to allow for nearby on-street parking for properties without residential parking permits.
