# Ogden Road Realignment Construction Start & Scope

Notice Date: October 2, 2025

To prepare for Green Line's Lynnwood/Millican Station, the stretch of Ogden Road S.E. between the CN railway bridge and 69 Avenue S.E. will be moved west. Work will begin as early as October 13 and will include installation of a water main and construction of a temporary multi-use pathway. Two-way vehicle access on Ogden and Millican roads will be maintained throughout construction.

Following an anticipated break over winter, the road realignment and associated works are scheduled for completion by early summer 2026.



### What

Road construction, utilities work, and tree removals

#### Where

Ogden Road S.E. (between the CN rail bridge and 69 Ave S.E.)

Millican Road S.E.

#### When

Oct 13 to early Dec, then again in spring 2026

#### What is the work?

To prepare for Green Line's Lynnwood/Millican Station, the stretch of Ogden Road S.E. between 69 Avenue S.E. and the CN railway bridge will be moved west.

#### Fall-Winter 2025 work

- Installation of a water main
- Construction of a temporary multi-use pathway

#### Spring 2026 work

- Removal of the current Ogden Road
- Construction of the new road and a multi-use pathway along the west side of the road
- Regrading and construction of Millican Road
- Construction of a new parking lot at the south end of Pop Davies Athletic Park
- Construction of the Lynnwood-Millican Road transit facility and parking lot

#### What to expect during construction

- Two-way vehicle access maintained on Ogden and Millican roads
- Pedestrian and cyclist access maintained via temporary multi-use pathway
- Parking access maintained for Pop Davies Athletic Park
- While mitigations will be in place, there may be dust, soil, and debris
- Some tree removals

## About Green Line LRT – S.E. Project

The S.E. Segment, from Shepard in the southeast to the Event Centre/Grand Central Station in the Beltline, will build the first 16 kilometres of an overall 46-kilometre vision, before connecting with the future Downtown Segment and into the existing Red and Blue LRT Lines. Including the Downtown Segment, Phase 1 will build, 17.2 kilometres of twin-track LRT infrastructure, 12 new stations, a maintenance and storage facility, three Park and Ride lots, and 28 new modern low-floor light rail vehicles.
