



Ogden Road Realignment: Millican Road Closure

Notice Date: February 26, 2026

To complete the installation of the new water main running along Ogden Road S.E., **Millican Road S.E. will be closed to through traffic from March 5 to 10.** Pedestrians will be able to access Millican Road and connect to Ogden Road via the existing temporary multi-use pathway. Vehicles will be able to access the community via 69 Avenue S.E., with detour signage in place. The bus stops for Route 24 on Millican Road will be temporarily closed. Riders can use the nearby stops at the corner of 62 Avenue S.E. and 18a Street S.E.

What is the work?

A new water main is being installed along the west side of Ogden Road S.E. To complete its installation, **Millican Road will be closed to through traffic** from March 5 to 10. A full road closure allows the water main to be installed as one continuous pipe, rather than in stages. This improves construction quality, reduces the risk of degradation over time, and helps avoid future maintenance and utility conflicts.

Pedestrians will be able to access Millican Road and connect to Ogden Road via the existing temporary multi-use pathway. **Vehicles** will be able to access the community via 69 Avenue S.E. Detour signage will be in place.

The **bus stops for Route 24** on Millican Road will be closed: WB Millican RD @ Lynnview RD (#5841) and EB Millican RD @ Lynnview RD (#9622).

About Green Line LRT – SE Project

The S.E. Segment, from Shepard in the southeast to the Event Centre/Grand Central Station in the Beltline, will build the first 16 kilometres of an overall 46-kilometre vision, before connecting with the future Downtown Segment and into the existing Red and Blue LRT Lines. Including the Downtown Segment, Phase 1 will build, 17.2 kilometres of twin-track LRT infrastructure, 12 new stations, a maintenance and storage facility, three Park and Ride lots, and 28 new modern low-floor light rail vehicles.
