



# Ogden Road Realignment: Upcoming Lane Closures

Notice Date: March 30, 2026

To connect the new water main running along Ogden Road S.E. to the main system, there will be lane closures on Millican Road and Ogden Road beginning as early as April 6. Two-way traffic will be maintained at both locations, though there may be delays during peak travel times. Weather and site conditions may affect the expected start and duration of the closures.

There will be future work and traffic disruption at the north end of Ogden Road to finish connecting the water main to the system. We will provide more information ahead of that work beginning.

#### About Green Line LRT – SE Project

The SE Segment, from Shepard in the southeast to the Event Centre/Grand Central Station in the Beltline, will build the first 16 kilometres of an overall 46-kilometre vision, before connecting with the future Downtown Segment and into the existing Red and Blue LRT Lines. Including the Downtown Segment, Phase 1 will build 17.2 kilometres of twin-track LRT infrastructure, 12 new stations, a maintenance and storage facility, three Park and Ride lots, and 28 new modern low-floor light rail vehicles.
