

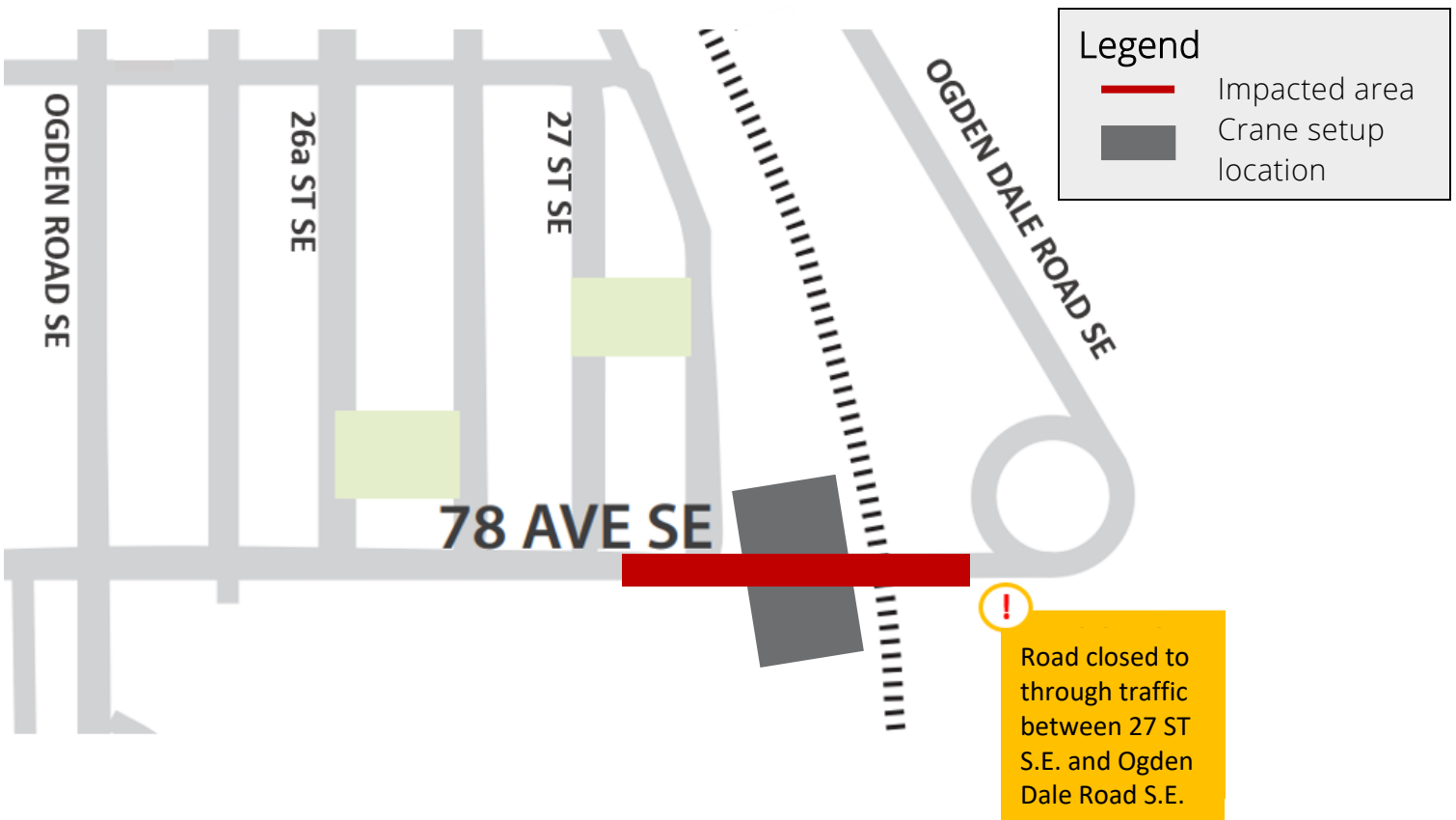


78 Avenue LRT Bridge - Girder Erection Work

Notice Date: August 19, 2026

As part of the construction of the 78 Avenue LRT Bridge for the Green Line LRT – SE Project, seven concrete girders (beams) must be erected onto the existing piles along 78 Ave S.E. This will require a **full** closure of 78 Ave S.E. between 27 St S.E. and Ogden Dale Road S.E. from August 24 to August 26.

Green Line LRT

What is the work?

As part of the next phase of construction of the 78 Avenue LRT bridge, the installation of girders will require the closure of 78 Ave S.E. between 27 St S.E. and Ogden Dale Road S.E. from August 24-26, 2026. This stage of work will require the transportation, lifting, and placement of several concrete girders onto the existing piles using a crane. Local access to residences on 78 Ave S.E. and 27 St S.E. will be maintained via Ogden Road S.E.

Businesses are reminded that 78 Ave S.E. is not a designated truck route. During the closure, commercial vehicles should continue to use approved truck routes and plan deliveries accordingly.

What to expect during construction:

- No vehicle, pedestrian, or cyclist access on 78 Ave S.E. between Ogden Dale Road S.E. and 27 St S.E. and through the underpass
- Noise and vibration during work hours
- Construction vehicles and equipment
- While mitigations will be in place, there may be dust, soil, and debris in the area

About Green Line LRT – SE Project

The SE Segment, from Shepard in the southeast to the Event Centre/Grand Central Station in the Beltline, will build the first 16 kilometres of an overall 46-kilometre vision, before connecting with the future Downtown Segment and into the existing Red and Blue LRT Lines. Including the Downtown Segment, Phase 1 will build, 17.2 kilometres of twin-track LRT infrastructure, 12 new stations, a maintenance and storage facility, three Park and Ride lots, and 28 new modern low-floor light rail vehicles.
