



Ogden Road Realignment: Upcoming road closure

Notice Date: September 23, 2026

To complete the next stage of utility work associated with the Ogden Road Realignment, two temporary road closures are required. Ogden Road S.E. between 68 Ave S.E. and Millican Road S.E. will be closed from 9:00 PM on September 25 until 5:00 AM on September 28, as well as 9:00 PM on October 2 until 5:00 AM on October 5, 2026. Millican Road and 68 Ave S.E. will remain open for community access. Pedestrians will be able to access the existing multi-use pathway. Vehicles travelling on Ogden Road S.E. will be detoured via Millican Road S.E. and 68 Ave S.E. Drivers can expect delays through this area for the duration of the closure.

What is the work?

To support construction of the Ogden Road Realignment project, crews need to complete a utility crossing. To conduct this work, **Ogden Road S.E. will be closed between 68 Ave S.E. and Millican Road S.E. from September 25 to September 28, and October 2 to October 5, 2026.** Please refer to calgary.ca/greenline/currentconstruction to check for changes or updates related to this closure.

Pedestrians and cyclists will still be able to access the existing multi-use pathway. For **vehicles**, access to Millican Road S.E. and 68 Ave S.E. will remain open and will serve as a **detour** through the community during the closure. Detour signage will be in place.

About Green Line LRT – SE Project

The SE Segment, from Shepard in the southeast to the Event Centre/Grand Central Station in the Beltline, includes the first 16 kilometres of an overall 46-kilometre vision, before connecting with the future Downtown Segment and into the existing Red and Blue LRT Lines. Including the Downtown Segment, Phase 1 includes 17 kilometres of twin-track LRT infrastructure, 11 new stations, a maintenance and storage facility, three Park and Ride lots, and 28 new modern low-floor light rail vehicles.
