



Olympic Way/4 Street S.E. and 11 Avenue Intersection Closure

Notice Update: August 28, 2023

Starting Saturday, August 12, the intersection of Olympic Way/4 Street S.W. and 11 Avenue S.E. will be closed to allow for phased utility relocation work. This work will also require the full closures of Olympic Way/4 Street S.E. between 9 and 12 Avenue S.E.; and 11 Avenue between Olympic Way and 5 Street S.E. Night work in the intersection may be required for up to two weeks starting as early as August 12, as crews complete this initial phase as quickly and safely as possible and reduce overall timelines for construction.

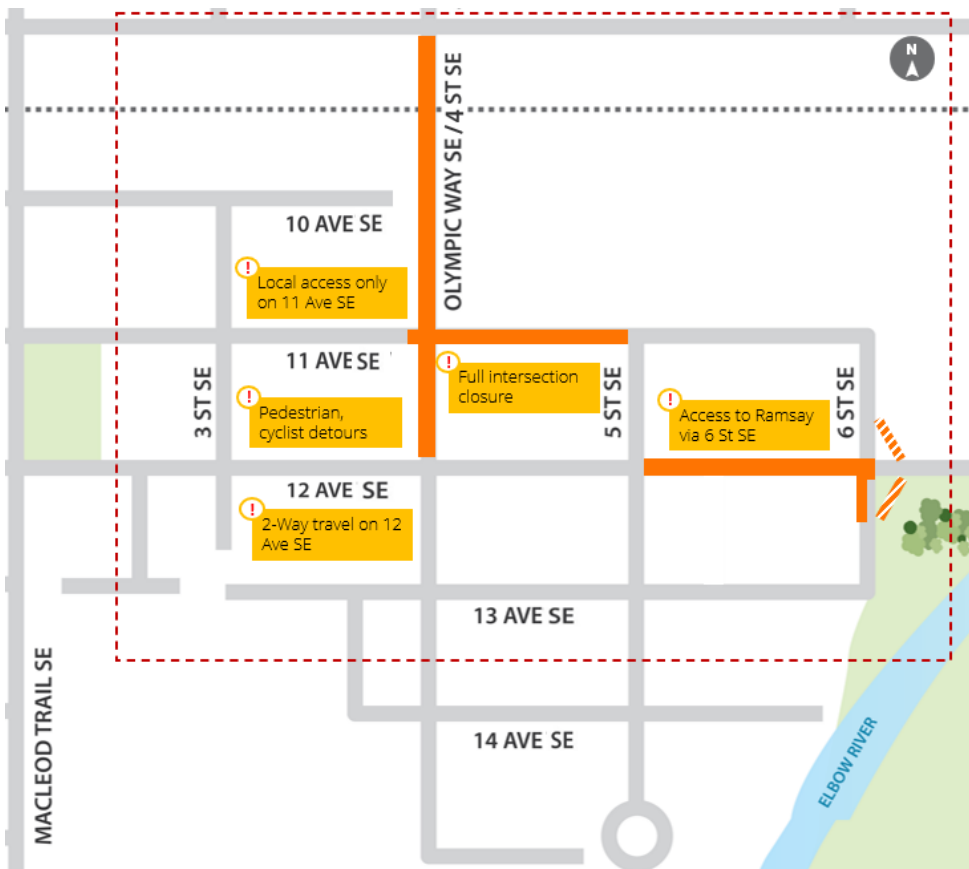

Green Line LRT

What is the work? Utility Relocation – Olympic Way/4 Street S.E. and 11 Avenue.

This work will be divided into phases. The following closures will be in place across all phases: A full intersection closure of Olympic Way/4 Street S.E. and 11 Avenue; and full road closures of Olympic Way/4 Street S.E. between 9 and 12 Avenue; 11 Avenue between Olympic Way/4 Street S.E. and 5 Street S.E.

- 4 Street underpass closed to vehicles.
- Main north-south pedestrian access maintained on west side of Olympic Way/4 Street S.E.
- Detour in place for 12 Avenue cycle track at 3 Street S.E. for duration of Beltline Downtown Utility Relocation Project.
- Two-way traffic on 11 Avenue between 3 Street S.E. and Olympic Way/4 Street S.E. Local access only. No thru traffic.
- Two-way traffic on 12 Avenue between Olympic Way and 3 Street S.E.
- Access to Ramsay via 6 Street S.E. and 12 Avenue. Follow detours.

Additional ongoing work in the area requires a full closure of 12 Avenue between 5 Street S.E. and 6 Street S.E. Traffic is being directed to a detour road just east of 6 Street S.E. Vehicle movement between Beltline and Ramsay will be maintained at all times. Follow detours.

About Green Line LRT

The Green Line is Calgary's next light rail transit (LRT) line. With \$5.5 billion in commitments from the Government of Canada, Government of Alberta and City of Calgary, it is the largest infrastructure investment in our city's history.

The current work in Beltline and Downtown is part of the utility relocation program required to make way for Phase 1 construction from Shepard to Eau Claire.
