Upcoming Road Closures for Utility Work

Notice Date: October 27

NEXT CONSTRUCTION PHASE: Targeting week of November 7

Targeting the week of November 7, the intersection of 12 Avenue and Olympic Way S.E. will be re-opened to all travel.

At that time, 12 Avenue will be closed between 5 Street S.E. and 6 Street S.E, including the partial closure of 12 Avenue and 6 Street S.E. intersection. A temporary road has been constructed to maintain vehicle access between 12 Avenue and 6 Street S.E. North-south pedestrian crossings at the intersection of 12 Avenue and 6 Street S. E. will not be possible during this phase but will remain in place at 12 Avenue and 5 Street S.E.

This next phase of construction is expected to be in place until approximately January 2023.

During this phase there may also be periodic temporary single lane closures in the area to allow for access to existing manholes, traffic signal work and utility exploration activities. Traffic will be maintained around these temporary work areas.

What is the work?

Construction of new City of Calgary deep utilities, including water, stormwater, and sanitary.

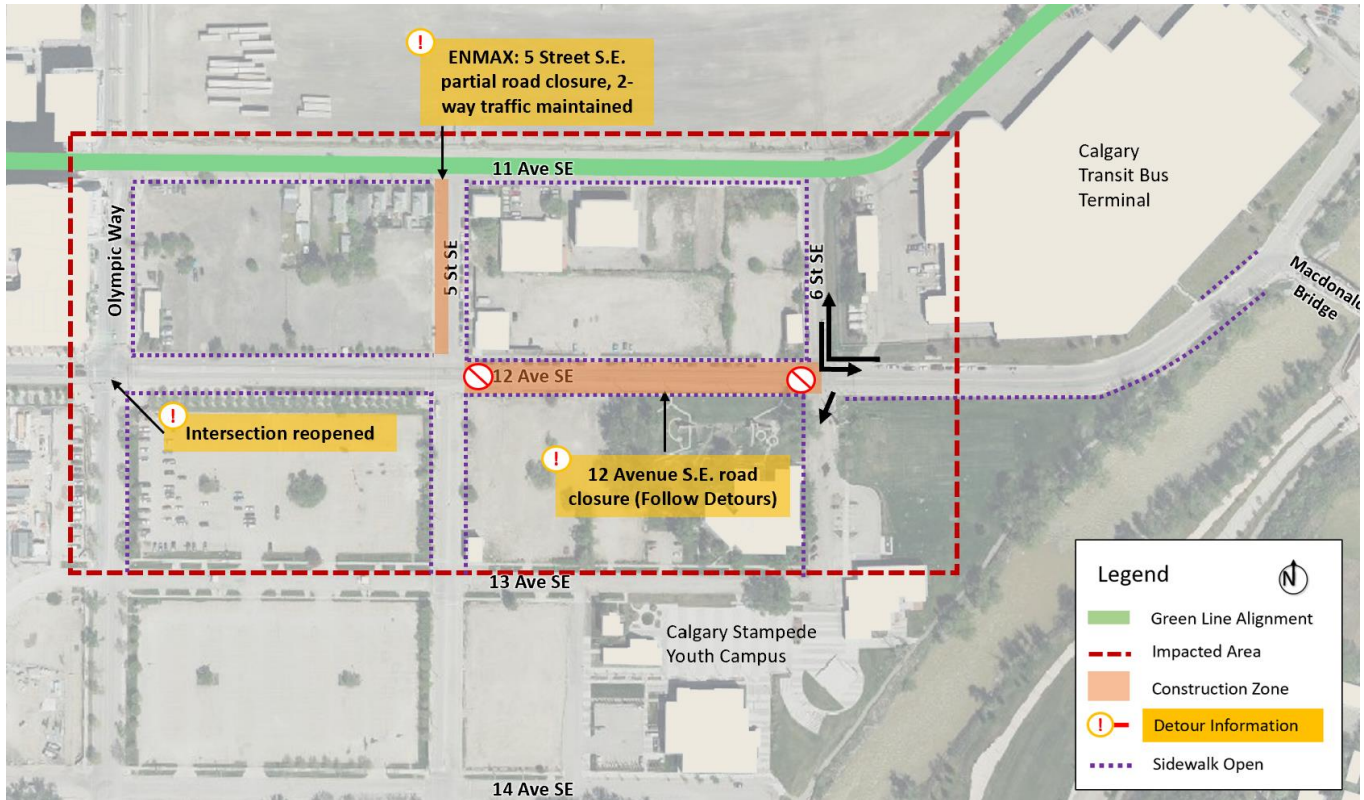
What can you expect?

- Partial closure of 5 Street S.E.
- Temporary single lane closures.
- Reduced pedestrian access.
- Construction noise.

About Green Line LRT

The Green Line is Calgary's next light rail transit (LRT) line. It is also the largest infrastructure investment in our city's history. It comes with \$4.9 billion in commitments from the Government of Canada, Government of Alberta, and City of Calgary.

Stage 1 will be built in 2 phases aligning with Council direction to build the Green Line in a stage-gate project approach. Phase 1 will build 18km of the LRT from Shepard to Eau Claire allowing for easier expansion both North and South. The current work in the Beltline and Downtown areas is part of the utility relocation program required to make way for Phase 1 construction.

Green Line is an important part of Calgary's economic recovery creating 20,000 jobs in Stage 1 alone and serves as a platform for long-term city building that will encourage redevelopment and investment opportunities in Calgary.
