



## Green Line LRT: **Road Closures at 11 Avenue S.E. and Olympic Way**

**Notice Date:** March 10, 2023 (Update)

**Construction Start:** March 15, 2023

**Duration:** Approximately 3 months

**Beginning March 15, the intersection of Olympic Way S.E. and 11 Avenue will be partially closed, with movement limited to west-to-north and south-to-east only. Olympic Way S.E. will also be closed between 11 and 12 Avenue.**

Both 11 and 12 Avenue S.E. will be configured to fully maintain localized access to buildings and businesses.

Some area crosswalks and sidewalks will be closed or restricted. Please follow detour signage.

The cycle track detour remains in place at 3 Street S.E., facilitating movement between 12 Avenue and Olympic Way S.E. via 10 Avenue.

Approximately two hours prior to and following major events in the area, an alternative traffic configuration will be in place, facilitating access and egress. Please follow detours and traffic controls.

Additional utility construction remains active further east on 12 Avenue between 5 and 6 Street S.E.

### **What is the work?**

New and upgraded water, stormwater, and sanitary infrastructure will be installed to make way for the eventual Green Line LRT tunnel on 11 Avenue.

Additional third-party utility work will remain active along 5 Street S.E. as required from 9:00 AM to 3:00 PM throughout March 2023.

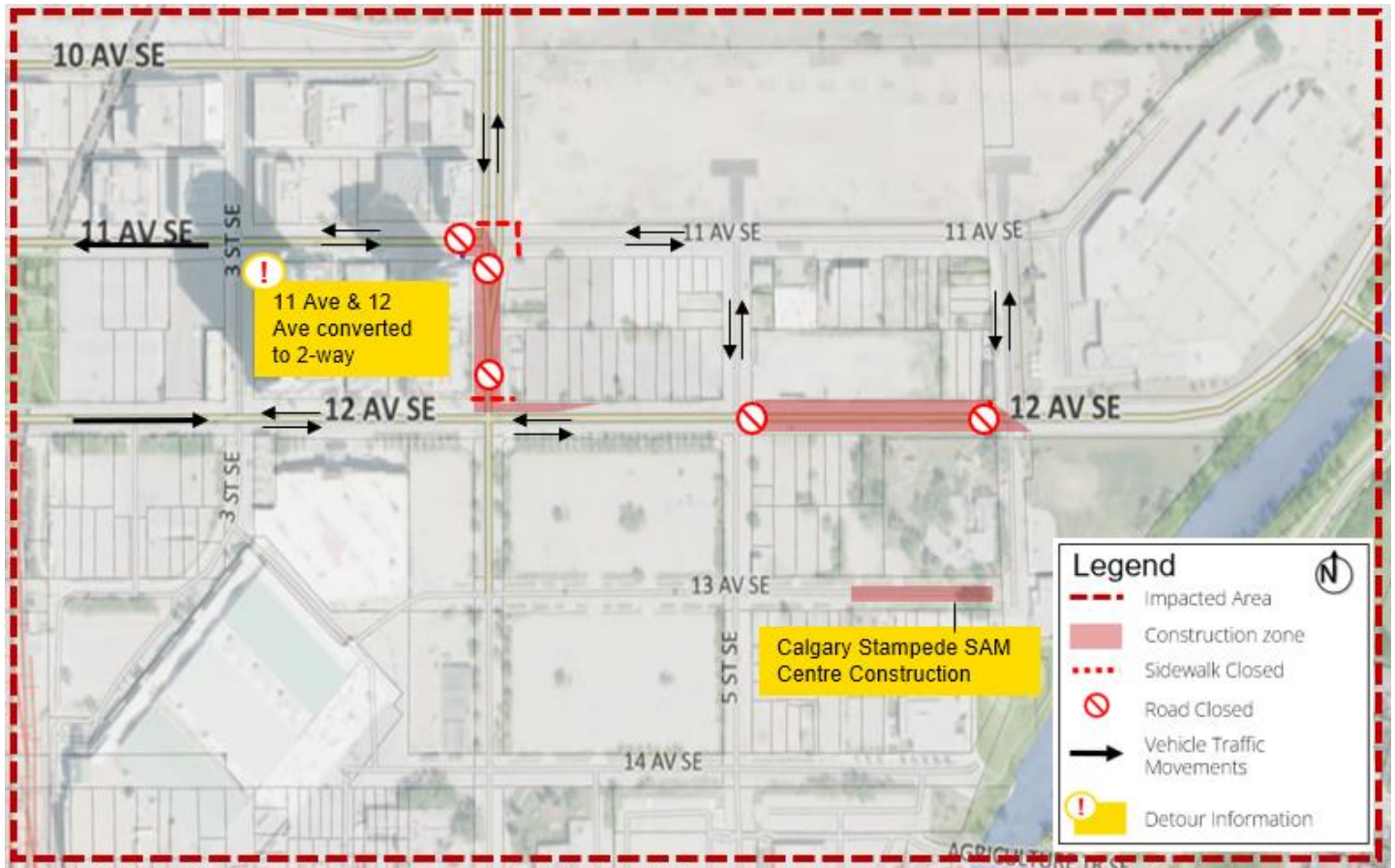
### **What can you expect?**

- Full closure of Olympic Way S.E. between 11 and 12 Avenue
- Full closure on 12 Avenue between 5 and 6 Street S.E.
- Tree removals along Olympic Way between 11 and 12 Avenue S.E.
- Detour in place for cycle track at 3 Street S.E. for duration of Beltline Downtown Utility Relocation Project
- Reduced pedestrian access
