# Centre Street S.E. Road Crossing Utility Work



Anticipated start date: Saturday, November 26

As part of the Green Line LRT Beltline Downtown Utility Relocation Project, partial road closures on Centre Street S. between 10 and 11 Avenues S, across 11 Avenue S., and on Centre Street S just south of 11 Avenue S will be in place for approximately two weeks beginning Saturday, November 26.

### What is the work?

Third-party utility duct banks will be installed down Centre Street S., between 10 and 11 Avenue S. crossing 11 Avenue S to a location just south of 11 Ave S. To facilitate this work, the west curbside traffic lane and half of the east lane, will be closed on Centre Street S. A lane for northbound traffic will be maintained on Centre Street S as well as the eastern sidewalk. The west sidewalk on Centre Street S will also be closed. The lane closures to cross 11 Avenue S. will be segmented into two phases to mitigate impacts.

### What can you expect?

- Lane closures on Centre Street S. across 11 Ave S. to the south side of 11 Ave S. Detour signage will be in place.
- The west side of Centre Street S, and half of the east side, will be closed 24 hrs a day north of 11 Ave S for the duration of the work.
- For the alleyway between 1 Street S.W. and Centre ST S, access between 10 Ave S.E. and 11 Ave S.E. will be closed from the east for approximately 4 days. Access to the alleyway from the west off 1 ST SW will be maintained during this time.
- West sidewalk access will be temporarily closed along Centre Street S. Pedestrian detours will be in place routing pedestrians to the south side of 11 Ave S during Phase 1, and the north side of 11 Ave during Phase 2.
- On-street public parking on Centre Street S will be removed between 11 Ave S. and the mid-block alleyway to the north.
- There will be general construction noise.
- Project duration is expected to be approximately two weeks.
- Work is scheduled from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. on weekdays and weekends. Work crossing 11 Avenue S. is scheduled for non-peak hours (e.g., 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.). All work times may be extended beyond 7 p.m. as required to minimize total days of impact.

### About Green Line LRT

The Green Line is Calgary's next light rail transit (LRT) line. It is also the largest infrastructure investment in our city's history. It comes with \$4.9 billion in commitments from the Government of Canada, Government of Alberta and City of Calgary.

Stage 1 will be built in 2 phases aligning with Council direction to build the Green Line in a stage-gate project approach. Phase 1 will build 18km of the LRT from Shepard to Eau Claire allowing for easier expansion both North and South. The current work in the Beltline and Downtown areas is part of the utility relocation program required to make way for Phase 1 construction.

Green Line is an important part of Calgary's economic recovery creating 20,000 jobs in Stage 1 alone and serves as a platform for long-term city building that will encourage redevelopment and investment opportunities in Calgary.
