

# 5 Avenue and 3 Street S.W. Closures

Notice Date: November 6, 2023

On Tuesday and Wednesday, November 7 and 8, 2023, the south three lanes of 5 Avenue will be closed between 2 and 3 Street S.W. to accommodate CDHI's utility relocation work. The closure will be reduced to the two south lanes for Thursday and Friday. This will be followed by a full closure of 5 Avenue between 2 and 4 Street S.W. on the weekend of November 10-13.



## What is the work? CDHI Utility Relocation – 5 Avenue between 2 and 3 Street S.W.

As part of CDHI utility relocation work, a closure of the south lanes of 5 Avenue is required between 2 and 4 Street S.W., access to loading docks and parkades will be maintained.

- Three south lanes closure of 5 Avenue between 2 and 4 Street S.W. on Tuesday and Wednesday.
- Two south lanes closure of 5 Avenue between 2 and 4 Street S.W. on Thursday and Friday.
- Access to parkades and loading docks maintained.
- Full road closure of 3 Street S.W. between 5 and 6 Avenue.
- Full road closure of 5 Avenue between 2 and 4 Street S.W. from November 10-13.

A full closure of 3 Street S.W., between 5 and 6 Avenue will remain in place for the duration of this closure.
