3 Street S.W. Road Closure; 5 Avenue S.W. Lane Closures

Notice Update: September 22, 2023

Starting on Monday, September 25, 2023, a full road closure of 3 Street S.W. between 5 and 6 Avenue is required to advance CDHI's utility relocation work. Prior to closing 3 Street S.W., the currently impacted lanes on 5 Avenue S.W. will reopen during the weekdays, but additional weekend closures will be required in the future to complete this work. Construction notices will be issued in advance.



<u>What is the work?</u> CDHI Utility Relocation –3 Street S.W. between 5 and 6 Avenue; 5 Avenue between 2 and 3 Street S.W.

As part of CDHI's utility relocation work, a full closure of 3 Street S.W. between 5 and 6 Avenue will be in place as of September 25, 2023. This closure is expected to last until mid-late October. This will be Phase 2 of the project:

- Full road closure of 3 Street S.W. between 5 and 6 Avenue S.W.
- Pedestrian detours.
- Removal of on-street parking.
- Phase 1of the project, currently active in the three middle lanes of 5 Avenue S.W. between 2 and 3 Street S.W., will continue with weekend-only work as early as September 29, 2023. Specific construction notices will be issued.
- Phase 3: Closure of two north lanes of 6 Avenue between 2 and 3 Street S.W. Starting in midlate October 2023.
