



Green Line Ground Investigations

Notice Date: March 14, 2025

Beginning March 17, Green Line is undertaking a series of borehole tests, identifying utility locations along the future LRT alignment. Test sites are limited to City-owned property but may impact general traffic in the area. Our construction partner will be working from 9:00 am to 3:00 pm where lane closures may be required, otherwise work will take place between 7:30 am and 5:30 pm.

Each investigation is expected to take one day with all investigations completed by early April. Where there are potential impacts to residences or businesses, Green Line will contact those who may be directly affected.
