Enabling 18,000 more homes to help increase Calgary's housing supply.



## Public Safety

Improving public safety downtown and on transit. Working with partners to support those experiencing homelessness, mental health and addiction issues.

**19%** goes to Government of Alberta

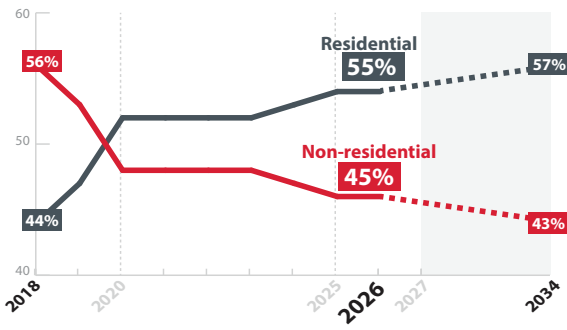

We collect property tax on behalf of the province. In 2026, the province increased their requisition by **8.7%** for non-residential properties. Over \$1.2 billion property tax goes to the province.

## Distributing property tax more fairly

In November 2025, Council cancelled a planned tax shift for 2026 due to economic pressures. Instead, Council approved a gradual tax change starting in 2027 to help support local businesses.
