Subject:

Hydronic heating permits

Background:

All hydronic heating system installations, alterations and additions in Calgary require permits. Builders, installers and homeowners are responsible for meeting the basic permit requirements.

Advisory:

Single construction permits, that include the hydronic process, include the installation and inspection of basement and/or attached garage hydronic heating systems only. If the scope of work is more than a basement and/or attached garage, an additional contractor's hydronic plumbing permit is required.

All other hydronic heating installations, alterations and additions require a contractor's hydronic plumbing permit. Minor repairs to leaks in hydronic heating systems or regular scheduled maintenance do not require permits. In all cases, certified design documents are required to be left on site for the safety codes officer to review at time of inspection.
