



**Electrical Discipline Advisory  
RE: FAIRS & CONCESSIONS**

Issued: July 9, 2010

An Electrical permit is required for Fairs & Concessions as per By Law 55M89 when:

- Temporary wiring (lighting & power) is attached to the steel structure
- Power is supplied to the structure from a permanent power source
- A generator is supplied that is required to be grounded
- The steel structure is required to be bonded to ground

The persons, firms or corporations eligible to apply for a Permit under Section 4 shall be an owner of an electrical contracting firm licensed in the City of Calgary who is certified as a Master Electrician in the Province of Alberta and licensed by authority of the Board of Certification and who is available on a full time basis to the said electrical contracting firm during normal working hours in the City of Calgary.

The wiring method shall be in compliance with Sections 10, 66, and 76- of the Canadian Electrical Code.

Fees for each concession at Fairs & Exhibitions shall be as per City of Calgary By-laws.

Where an Electrical Inspection is made and the Fees are not covered in Schedule "A," the Electrical Inspection Section shall charge an hourly fee of \$97.00.
