PERMITS FOR TEMPORARY TENTS

Subsection 3.1.6. "Tents and Air-Supported Structures"

Question:

When does a temporary tent require a Building Permit?

Commentary / Relevant Facts / Conclusion:

A temporary tent requires a Building Permit if:

- a) the area exceeds 55 m2, or
- b) it will be occupied for more than three days.
