BARRIER-FREE WASHROOM REQUIREMENTS IN EXISTING BUILDINGS

Reference: Article 3.8.1.1., Article 3.8.2.1. and Div C, Sentence 2.2.1.4.(1)

Article 3.8.1.1. "Application"

Article 3.8.2.1. "Areas Requiring a Barrier-Free Path of Travel"

Div C, Sentence 2.2.1.4.(1)"Barrier-Free Relaxations". "The Chief Building Administrator may grant relaxation of one or more of the requirements of **Section 3.8** if an owner can demonstrate to the satisfaction of the Chief Building Administrator that

- a) the specific requirements are unnecessary, or
- b) extraordinary circumstances prevent conformance.

Commentary / Relevant Facts / Conclusion:

This decision applies to new tenancies and renovation and/or expansion of existing tenancies.

If there is no barrier-free access to a building, barrier-free washrooms are not required.

If barrier-free access is provided into a building, barrier-free washrooms are required per code for new buildings and to existing buildings where there are major renovations to existing washrooms involving plan changes or relocations of plumbing fixtures or if new washrooms are added.

Requests for relaxation for any other reason may be submitted directly to the Chief Building Administrator under
