



Bridgeland Main Street: 2026 Construction Notice

Construction on the Bridgeland Main Street project will return this spring, building on the important work we completed along 1 Avenue N.E. in 2025. The project is part of The City's broader Main Streets program (calgary.ca/MainStreets).

1 Avenue N.E. (4 to 6 Street N.E.)

Starting the week of April 8, 2026 – Enmax work

- **Scope of work:** Enmax will be in the area to remove old overhead powerlines and wood poles along 1 Avenue N.E. between 4 and 6 Street N.E. Temporary traffic lane and sidewalk closures along 1 Avenue N.E. will be required to complete this work. Vehicle traffic and pedestrian access will be maintained wherever it is safe to do so, with detours and signage in place as needed.
- **Duration:** Construction is scheduled overnight on **April 8, 2026 (10 p.m. to 5 a.m.)**, and during the day on **April 15 and 16 (8 a.m. to 5 p.m.)**.

Starting the week of April 20, 2026 – Streetscape improvements

- **Scope of work:** Construction will focus on completing the final streetscape upgrades along 1 Avenue N.E. between 4 and 6 Street N.E. We will be widening sidewalks and upgrading street lighting to improve pedestrian safety, while adding new street furniture to enhance comfort. Decorative grasses and new trees will be installed to beautify and enhance the area.
- As part of this work, some sections of old sidewalk will be excavated and removed to allow crews to make the streetscape improvements.
- **Duration:** Construction is expected to start the week of April 20, 2026. This work will occur in two phases, with construction on the south side and north side of 1 Avenue N.E. taking approximately 8 weeks per side.

Temporary Parking Changes

To complete this work:

- Some on-street parking along 1 Avenue N.E. will be temporarily removed.
- Select on-street permit parking areas will also allow 2-hour public parking, while still being available for all-day residential permit holders. This helps support short-term access for customers, visitors, and nearby businesses.

What to Expect

Construction work may occur Monday to Saturday anytime between 7 a.m. and 7 p.m., with occasional work on weekends and overnight as required. Construction work is variable, and timelines are subject to change depending on factors such as complexity, weather, and supply chain.

We know that construction impacts can be disruptive, and we will work to mitigate impacts as best as we can. Please be sure to follow all posted construction and detour signage in the area for your safety and that of construction crews. While we will make every effort to minimize impacts, Calgarians living, visiting, or travelling through the area can expect:

- Traffic detours and lane closures
- Pathway and sidewalk closures
- Temporary parking changes
- Temporary business access detours
- Increased noise, dust, and construction vehicles in the area

Businesses remain open throughout construction, and pedestrian access will be maintained in the area.
