- 6. Continuous streetwall
- 7. Façade improvement programs

- 10. Increase pedestrian safety
- 11. Bike route might be better on Bowwood Dr
- 12. Encouraging (or requiring) smaller Commercial/Retail Unit (CRU) bays in developments to promote independent, local businesses

ISSUES

- Bowness Mall needs attention (multiple ownership is an issue)
- 2. Lack of green space and places for people to sit and gather
- Street is not really animated in evening
- 4. Bike routes not well maintained
- on Bow Crescent, cars often block the way
- 5. Barren, a lack of trees
- Sidewalks feel disjointed with gaps and greater connectivity is needed
- 7. No boutique-type stores
- (clothing, furniture etc.) that would draw people to the neighbourhood
- Current retail that doesn't work: auto body shops and gas stations
- Existing green spaces are underutilized and unwelcoming
- 10. Speeding is a problem
- 11. Need to do more to discourage cut-through traffic
- 12. Main Street is underbuilt, more density is needed to support businesses
