



Marda Loop Main Streets Upcoming July Work

Construction is underway! Over the last month, we've been working on road reconstruction, hydrant and water infrastructure upgrades, and laying the groundwork for signal lights and crosswalk lights. We appreciate the community's patience as we're getting started.

We'll be working on several things in the coming weeks. Below is more information about the more prominent pieces of work.

Traffic Signal Work

On July 17 and 18, we will be installing steel infrastructure on the east and west sides of the 34 Avenue S.W. and 22 Street intersection to support the new traffic lights. There will be temporary pedestrian detours in place to accommodate this work, but we don't expect any vehicle impacts. Access to businesses and residences will be maintained during this work.

Borehole Testing

On July 19 and 20, we will be conducting borehole testing at three locations along 34 Avenue S.W. at 21, 19, 18, and 17 Streets. This necessary work will allow us to understand the waterline system and plan construction accurately. We expect the work to take approximately two hours in each location. Homes and businesses near this work may experience a temporary increase in noise and dust during this work. There will be localized and temporary vehicle detours, pedestrian detours, and no parking signs in place. Please be watchful while travelling in the area as conditions/restrictions will change as this work progresses.

Continued Intersection Work on 33 Avenue S.W.

Once we've completed work on the south side of the 20 and 22 Street intersections, we'll be moving to the south side of the 19 and 21 Street intersections. We expect this move to happen the week of July 17. Work will be similar; we'll be doing road reconstruction, hydrant work and installing crosswalk infrastructure. We expect to be in these two locations for approximately 2-3 weeks (conditions permitting). Similar vehicle and pedestrian detours will be in place.
