



## **Marda Loop Main Streets** **Upcoming Water Service Disruption: November 3 & 6**



We wanted to share an upcoming piece of work that is required to support ENMAX's overhead line burial and our continued Marda Loop Main Streets project work.

**This Friday, November 3 and Monday, November 6, 2023, there will be a short water service disruption lasting approximately 3 hours. During the shutoff, crews will be relocating water service valves along 34 Avenue between 20 and 19 Streets S.W. Water will be turned off from 8 a.m. to 11 a.m. both days to support this work, pending weather and site conditions.**

While water is off, we recommend that businesses and residents keep their taps closed to prevent flooding when water is turned back on, and to turn off hot water tanks to prevent damage.

There will also be temporary on-street parking restrictions and pedestrian detours to maintain a safe space for crews to work. Please be alert and aware of directional signage onsite.

The overhead line burial (which includes ENMAX power lines and telecommunications lines) will be complete in 2024. Work will happen in several phases, each of which will look different.

- The first is active construction, which consists of digging and installing electrical conduit underground. This looks like active construction, where machinery and crews are visible.
- Crews will then pull new utility cables into the new underground infrastructure. This work is quieter, as localized closures are utilized to complete this activity.
- Finally, the overhead lines will be removed. This will be more visible work and will not happen all at once as the different utilities on the overhead lines will need to be removed separately. Expect to see the poles to stay in place until the new streetlights are installed later in 2024.
