




West 17 Main Street Project

The City of Calgary has developed a streetscape master plan for West 17 Avenue. These improvements compliment land use changes along 17 Avenue that were approved in 2017, and construction will start this summer. Some of the significant design improvements to the street include:

- Creating a street that represents the diverse and eclectic nature of 17 Avenue.
- Intersection improvements and new street lighting
- Upgrading the utilities along 17 Ave between 26 and 29 St SW, and on 26 St between Bow Trail and 17 Ave SW
- Improved pedestrian comfort, connectivity and safety with wider sidewalks, multi-use pathways, and curb extensions
- Maintenance work on the Crowchild Trail bridge

When construction starts this summer, we will maintain one lane of traffic in each direction on 17 Avenue. We will also make sure access to businesses and residences is maintained while crews are working.

For the 2020 construction season, we will be working on intersection improvements and roadwork. Underground utility work along 17 Avenue will start in 2021. We will work with stakeholders, businesses, and the community to minimize the impact of construction as much as possible. We anticipate construction will be complete by the fall of 2022.
