




37 Street Main Street Project

The City of Calgary has developed a streetscape master plan for 37 Street SW. These improvements compliment land use changes along 37 Street that were approved in 2017, and construction will start this summer. Some of the significant design improvements to the street include:

- Creating a street that reflects the surrounding communities, and everyone who uses the street whether it be on foot, bike, or car
- A new multi-use pathway on the east side of 37 Street
- A new road surface between Bow Trail and Richmond Road SW
- Improved pedestrian comfort on the street with enhanced pedestrian crossings, and a new boulevard space that includes planting approximately 300 new trees

When construction starts this summer, we will maintain one lane of traffic in each direction on 37 Street. We will also make sure access to businesses and residences is maintained while crews are working.

We will work with stakeholders, businesses, and the community to minimize the impact of construction as much as possible. We anticipate construction will be complete by the fall of 2022.
