



This checklist outlines all the information necessary to evaluate and provide a timely decision on your application. Applications and materials submitted must be clear, legible, and precise.

NOTE: This information is required for validation of personal information. Once verified by staff, these documents will be removed properly from our records.

Section 1: Minimum Application Requirements

A. Provide 2 forms of Acceptable Identification

At minimum, one form of identification must include a photograph

Acceptable types of photograph identification

- 1 Driver’s Licence (interim licence is not a valid identification)
- 2 Alberta photo identification card (issued through registry agent offices, common among non-drivers)
- 3 Passport
- 4 Permanent resident card (expired date is accepted)
- 5 Firearms licence
- 6 Nexus airport card
- 7 Secure certificate of Indian Status card (federally issued)
- 8 Aviation document booklet
- 9 Refugee protection claimant document (must be certified)

Acceptable types of non-photograph identification

- 1 Provincial health care card
 - 2 Birth certificate
 - 3 Marriage certificate
 - 4 Immigration documents (including any valid document issued by Citizenship & Immigration Canada)
 - 5 Citizenship card
 - 6 Citizenship certificate
