## AMENDMENTS TO THE LAND USE BYLAW (1P2007) BYLAW 27P2021

As part of the City's commitment and priority to support businesses and economic recovery, amendments to the Land Use Bylaw are being proposed. These changes will:

- 1. Streamline processes and simplify uses by:
  - Collapsing 7 restaurant uses into 2; Restaurant: Licensed and Restaurant: Food Service Only.
  - Combining the uses of Counselling Service, Health Services Laboratory With Clients and Medical Clinic to the new use of "Health Care Service".
  - O Absorbing "Market" into the "Retail and Consumer Service" use.
  - O Clarify rules for mechanical screening.
  - Allow the use of Child Care Service to be used for calculating the minimum requirement of 300.0 square metres of commercial multi-residential uses in the M-X1 and M-X2 Districts.
- 2. Other housekeeping amendments.

## AMENDMENTS TO THE LAND USE BYLAW (1P2007) BYLAW 28P2021

This bylaw proposes amendments to delete the use of Home Based Child Care – Class 2; allow one (1) non-resident employee for Home Based Child Care – Class 1; and other associated amendments. These amendments are being proposed to align with the Alberta Government's changes to the *Early Learning and Child Care Act*.
