


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



Project overview

The Richmond Green Park Redevelopment project will transform a previously underutilized park into a vibrant destination for Calgarians.

The project aims to:

- Expand greenspace and natural amenities
- Improve and diversify recreational amenities for all ages and abilities
- Enhance pathway connections to surrounding communities

Public engagement for this project was held in 2021, 2022 and 2023. The new park design focuses on addressing access through the park, additional open green space, improving amenities, additional pathways and park connectivity to surrounding communities.

Once complete, Richmond Green Regional Park will serve as a welcoming space balancing recreation, community gathering spaces and environmental stewardship.

Richmond Green Park design revisions

Since sharing the preferred concept design in fall 2023, we've continued to refine the park design.

The design shared today was shaped by community feedback, site constraints, park planning principles, budget, technical feasibility and growing recreation needs.

The revisions aim to:

- Balance recreational needs
- Protect natural features
- Improve accessibility
- Enhance the quality of park amenities
- Popular amenities that will be retained in the park include the toboggan hill and large baseball diamond
