



Parks Special Tax Levy Homeowner's Assistance Program (Pilot)

Frequently Asked Questions

Am I still expected to pay my Property tax Bill?

Yes. The Parks Special Tax Levy Homeowner's Assistance Program is separate from your property taxes.

Will the Parks Special Tax Levy Homeowner's Assistance Program cover my entire special tax levy bill?

The program will provide a subsidy up to \$50.00. If approved, you will still need to pay any amount owing above and beyond \$50.00.

What will happen at the end of the pilot program?

What happens if my Fair Entry status changes before the end of the application date for the pilot program?

If your Fair Entry eligibility changes during the application period for the Parks Special Tax Levy Homeowner's Assistance pilot program, you will remain eligible for the subsidy, provided your application is approved prior to any change in status. If your status changes prior to approval of your application, you may no longer be eligible for the subsidy.
