Thistle, Canada Cirsium arvense Asteraceae (Sunflower Family)

- Information: Introduced from Europe.
- Life cycle: Perennial.
- · Root: Horizontal and vertical.
- Leaves: Alternate, wavy, lance shaped, lobed, spine-tipped and lack stalks; Upper leaves smaller than lower leaves.
- Stems: 30-120cm tall, lack spines, erect, ridged, branched, and slightly hairy.
- Flower: Purple fading to white with diameter of 1.5-2cm form clusters at branch ends.
  Bracts have weak prickles (no spines).
- Seed/Fruit: Long, flattened seeds with tufts of white hairs.
- Control: Chemical, late fall application.
