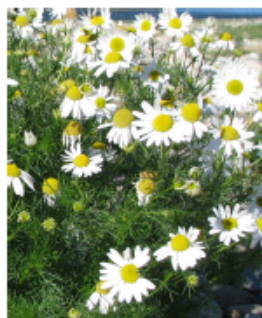


Chamomile, Scentless
Tripleurospermum perforatum
Asteraceae (Sunflower Family)

Noxious



- . **Information:** Introduced from Eurasia, also known as Mayweed, False Chamomile.
- . **Life Cycle:** Annual, biennial, or short lived perennial.
- . **Root:** Fibrous roots.
- . **Leaves:** Fern-like leaves are highly branched, glossy and scentless.
- . **Stems:** Stems are branched, and can be up to 1m tall.
- . **Flower:** Terminal flowers, yellow centre (disk florets), and white petals (ray florets).
- . **Seed/Fruits:** Prolific seed production.
- . **Toxicity:**
- . **Control:** Hand pick, chemical control before seed set.
