The 2025 Capacity Building Fund is designed to empower eligible non-profits for one-time projects that enhance social impact and address emerging issues by strengthening organizational effectiveness. This fund supports organizations in building internal capacity to become more effective, sustainable, and responsive to Calgarians experiencing vulnerabilities. Eligible projects focus on increasing adaptive or technical capacity, going beyond regular operations or program activities to strengthen the organization's overall sustainability and responsiveness.

Eligible one-time projects must be completed, and funds spent, by December 31, 2025.

Applicants must upload their most recent approved provincial or federal annual return, or an organizational financial statement in the Documents section of FIMS. Please DO NOT attach or link additional documents to this application.
