## Preparing for the Green Line LRT: Ogden Road S.E. utility line relocation Ogden Road S.E. traffic impacts, Spring 2020

In preparation for the Green Line LRT, The City will be completing several Enabling Works construction projects along the future Green Line alignment. These projects include utility relocations and land preparation. Doing this work now ensures the right-of-way will be ready for major Green Line construction scheduled to start on tracks and stations in 2021.

Starting on approximately April 27 and lasting for approximately 3 months, Enmax will be completing both civil construction and electrical work in the area. This will impact roadways between 69 Avenue SE and 74 Avenue SE. It will also impact sidewalks in the area. Crews will be working Monday to Friday from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. with occasional off-peak hours as required.



### TRAFFIC IMPACTS (Spring 2020)

Temporary single-lane closures will be in effect to accommodate this work. Traffic accommodations will be in place to maintain two-directional traffic. Access to all residential and commercial buildings will be maintained during construction.

### HOW TO PREPARE FOR CONSTRUCTION

ENMAX will be working within the City-owned road allowance, which will include excavation along existing roadways, sidewalks, pathways and greenspaces. After work is complete, ground disturbance will be restored. Any landscaping beyond legal property lines is considered an encroachment onto City-owned land and will be removed.

Please ensure that the red zone in the following maps is clear of any obstructions prior to construction starting. Any vegetation/obstructions that are not moved as requested will be removed to provide a safe working environment.
