Canada Day & Calgary Stampede

FAQ

What roads will be closed for Canada Day and during the Calgary Stampede?

Ramsay drivers will need to show their 2022 Stampede Access Permit from 5:30 p.m. to 11:30 p.m. on July 1, and July 7 through 17, 2022, to have vehicle access to some streets in the community.

Resident vehicle access is at:

- Bellevue Avenue and MacDonald Avenue S.E.
- Burns Avenue and Spiller Road S.E.

There is no vehicle access to west Ramsay from Spiller Road and 8 Street S.E. at these intersections:

- Maggie Street and MacDonald Avenue S.E.
- 11 Avenue and 8 Street S.E.
- 17 Avenue and 8 Street S.E.
- Margaret Avenue and Spiller Road S.E.
- Constance Avenue and Spiller Road S.E.
- 6 Street and Spiller Road S.E.

During what times will these roads be closed? What times on July 1 and July 7 through 17, will the vehicle access points be controlled?

Ramsay drivers will need to show their 2022 Stampede Access Permit from 5:30 p.m. to 11:30 p.m. on July 1, and July 7 through 17, 2022, to have vehicle access to some streets in the community as listed above. Drivers can show their Permits at the two vehicle access locations listed above.

Who will get a 2022 Stampede Access Permit?

2022 Stampede Access Permits have been delivered to Ramsay homes that require them. If you should have received a Permit, and haven't, please go to one of the vehicle access points between 5:30 p.m. and 11:30 p.m. on July 1, or July 7 – 17, with your driver's license, showing proof of residence, to get a Permit.

Will the roads closed on July 1, be open July 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6, 2022?

The roads will remain closed, with cement barricades installed on June 30 and removed on July 18. During these dates, there will be no need to show your 2022 Stampede Access Permit. You will be able to drive into the area at the two vehicle access points freely, at any time.

How can guests who don't live in the affected area of Ramsay, visit family and friends?

If you have visitors driving to your home between 5:30 p.m. and 11:30 p.m. on July 1 or July 7-17, you will need to meet your guests at one of the two vehicle access points with your Stampede Access Permit or your driver's license, so they can access the area.

What does the 2022 Stampede Access Permit allow? Can a vehicle with a 2022 Stampede Access Permit, park in a No-Parking zone?

The 2022 Stampede Access Permit allows drivers in the affected area of Ramsay, to drive their vehicles to their homes. Drivers are still required to follow all other parking and driving laws and bylaws.
