



Crowchild Trail Upgrades: Fall 2017-Fall 2019

The upgrades we're making to Crowchild Trail and the surrounding roads will make it easier for people travelling through the area. It's one of Calgary's few north-south connections on the city's west side and an important access in and out of downtown.



Upgrades

Bridges/roadway

- 1 Complete life cycle rehabilitation on the Memorial Drive, Bow River, and Bow Trail bridges
- 2 Add a northbound and southbound traffic lane on Crowchild Trail between Memorial Drive and Bow Trail
- 3 Add a northbound traffic lane on Crowchild Trail between Memorial Drive and 5 Avenue N.W.

On and off ramps

- 4 From westbound Bow Trail/10 Avenue S.W. to northbound Crowchild Trail: move on-ramps to right side of Crowchild Trail
- 5 From northbound Crowchild Trail to eastbound Bow Trail: add a merge lane to the off-ramp
- 6 From northbound Crowchild Trail to eastbound Memorial Drive: move the off-ramp to the north side of eastbound Memorial Drive

Pathways and crossings

- 7 Along the east side of Crowchild Trail from Kensington Road along the north side of Memorial Drive: add a pathway, connecting to the pedestrian overpass at 21 Street N.W.
- 8 Parkdale Boulevard and Kensington Road intersection: add a signalized pedestrian crossing to connect to the Bow River Pathway

Related work

- 9 In select locations along Crowchild Trail: build noise walls with accompanying landscape improvements
- 10 Construct new ramp on westbound 16 Avenue N.W. connecting to northbound Crowchild Trail
- 11 Upper 17 Avenue Streetscape Master Plan: public realm improvements through the Main Streets initiative
- 12 In select locations along the riverbank, repair work to outfalls and erosion sites which suffered damage from the 2013 floods
