



## Inglewood/Ramsay City Projects Update – January 2020

### 8 Street S.E. Closure Update

**Reminder:** 8 Street S.E. will be closed at the crossing with CP Rail south of 9 Avenue S.E. **tomorrow**. The City will be permanently closing the CP Rail crossing at 8 Street S.E. starting on Jan.15.

#### **New Route Options for people walking, cycling or driving:**

- **People walking:** Use the Elbow River Pathway on the east side of the Elbow River under the CP Rail tracks to connect to north and southbound 8 Street S.E.
- **People cycling:** Use the Elbow River Pathway on the east side of the Elbow River under the CP Rail tracks to connect to north and southbound 8 Street S.E.
- **People driving:** Use MacDonald Avenue bridge to 12 Avenue S.E. to Olympic Way **or** use southbound 8 Street S.E. to 21 Avenue S.E. to 11/12 Street S.E.

## 9 Avenue S.E. Bridge Replacement - Construction Update

It's been a busy fall and winter construction season for the 9 Avenue S.E. bridge replacement project, with work moving forward as planned through the cold and snowy weather.

### Construction progress


Crews began construction of the new bridge in early November, following the removal of the original bridge in October. New concrete abutments, which will provide support for the bridge on both sides of the riverbank, have been completed. Current work is focused on preparing the site for steel installation and cranes have been brought on-site to facilitate this work.

### Taking shape

In addition to the on-site construction, steel components that will form the base of the bridge are being manufactured at an off-site facility. Over the next few weeks, these materials will be prepared for shipping to site. You'll start to see the bridge take shape in the coming months as the major steel components – including the arch – are installed.

## **Inglewood Sanitary Trunk – Construction Update**

In early 2020, City crews will begin work on the last three sections of the Inglewood Sanitary Trunk which will be installed by microtunnelling.

From late January to February, we are installing the section of trunk that runs from 26 Avenue S.E. at Crossroads Market to Blackfoot Trail S.E. Drivers may experience temporary traffic disruptions towards completion of this work.

We are also starting construction on the two sections of trunk originating from 9 Street S.E. and Adelaide Street S.E. Work is expected to take four months, with some periods of 24-hour construction resulting in some light and noise. Every effort will be made to minimize the impact to residents in this area and we thank residents for their patience as we complete this work.
