



Inglewood Ramsay City Projects Update – July 2019

Stampede Construction Updates

The following City construction projects in Ramsay and Inglewood have been granted permission to continue work during the Calgary Stampede from July 4 to 14.

Inglewood Sanitary Trunk

Construction of a shaft at Adelaide Street S.E. and 9 Street S.E. started the week of June 24 and will continue to the end of July. The retaining wall on 9 Street S.E., including the art mural, will be removed and the green space west of it graded. Although this retaining wall had been previously scheduled to be removed due to its aging condition and proximity to the planned cul-de-sac, it is happening earlier than anticipated to allow for safer travel of heavy equipment in and out of the area. The road at Adelaide Street S.E. and 8 Street S.E. will remain closed for Green Line construction but no additional road closures will be required through Stampede.

9 Avenue Bridge Replacement

While construction will continue through Stampede, impact to traffic will be minimal. Construction will be contained within the construction zone and people can continue travelling through the area, as they do now.

Green Line:

- **Jefferies Park** - Landscaping is scheduled to start July 8 and be completed by July 19. This includes hydroseeding or sodding, and restoring Jefferies Park to a green space. There will be no street shut downs during this period as paving on 11 Avenue S.E. and 10 Street S.E. was completed on July 1 and streetlighting was completed on July 3.
- **11 Street & 20 Avenue S.E.** - Enmax crews will be open trenching across 20 Avenue. Exact date of crossing has not been determined yet.
- **11 Street & 26 Avenue S.E.** - Enmax crews will be working throughout Stampede around this intersection and on the north side of 26 Avenue. Crews will be installing cables but they will not be impacting traffic.

Upcoming Engagement Events

We are still planning opportunities for Calgarians to provide input this summer on the following two projects:

1. **The Interpretation Plan for the 110-year-old 9 Avenue S.E. bridge** – review the proposed options on how best to honor the bridge
2. **Jack Long Park** – share your thoughts on a unique feature we want to develop in the park, honouring the neighbourhoods and community

Sounding boards and a pop-up event will be coordinated for these two projects in Inglewood and Ramsay. There will also be an opportunity to provide input online. More details to come.

9 Avenue S.E. Bridge Replacement – Construction Update

Crews have almost completed the temporary 9 Avenue S.E. bridge. We're currently scheduled to switch traffic from the existing bridge to the temporary bridge during the week of July 15. Once the date is confirmed, we will do the traffic switch overnight to minimize disruption to access and people travelling in the area. As we get closer to the week of July 15, we will update you with the date and time when we will move traffic over, including road closures and other possible impacts as part of the transition.
