

Inglewood/ Ramsay City Projects Update – May 2021

Inglewood Bird Sanctuary Reconnection Project

We are making updates to the lagoon, reconnecting it to the Bow River and making other improvements to the area to provide a continuous stream of water to the lagoon. This work will ensure the health and longevity of the lagoon, improve water conditions and protect against future flood damage. We are also creating habitat for the fish, birds and wildlife in the park and enhancing the experience park visitors.

Construction will begin July 2021 and will be completed in three stages. During this time there will be temporary park and pathway closures.

Guidebook for Great Communities - Project Update

The <u>Guide for Local Area Planning</u> was considered and accepted by SPC on Planning for Urban Development (PUD) on May 5, 2021.

We will use the document, including the 62 changes, as a best-practice guide as we work together (with citizens and other stakeholders) to plan our communities through the local area planning process. We're excited to begin using the Guide with you in this capacity. In our continued work together, we are committed to ensure our documents, including the Guide, are reflective of communities' needs and we are committed to refining, learning, educating and engaging with Calgarians as we advance the planning system. A refreshed version of the Guide for Local Area Planning will be available online in the coming weeks.

The new default unposted speed limit on neighbourhood streets will change to 40 km/h as of **May 31, 2021**. The changes to the default unposted speed limit are on the streets that make the biggest impact to Calgarians' lives – the street in front of their home.
