## New Outdoor Amenity – Inglewood Bike Pump Track

Regional pathway users have a new amenity to enjoy in the green space located at 7 Avenue and 20 Street S.E. The Inglewood Bike Pump Track is now open to bike enthusiasts and less experienced cyclists alike with two custom-designed asphalt tracks, benches and a picnic table. Bike pump tracks are progressive circuits where riders use an up and down pumping motion to propel the bike forward instead of pedaling. Calgarians are encouraged to use active modes of transportation to visit the pump track.

A temporary sign has been placed in the parking lot near the pump track identifying the location of the nearest public washrooms and additional parking locations. A baseline traffic count was completed before construction on the pump track started and a second traffic count is planned for spring 2022 to determine if traffic measures are required.

The bike pump track, built in partnership with Parks Foundation Calgary, was funded by a variety of sources including the provincial Municipal Stimulus Program (MSP), Parks Foundation Calgary and the Calgary Flames Foundation.
