37 Street/46 Avenue S.W. (Richardson Way S.W.) intersection		Modify the intersection to manage traffic flow, with specific changes for vehicles traveling north and west.	Schedule is to be determined, prior to 2021.

Glenmore Trail/Crowchild Trail interchange		Modify the current interchange to manage traffic moving from east to north.	Design is expected to occur in 2017 followed by construction in 2018.
