

Bicycle Program

As part of the Cycling Strategy and the Calgary Transportation Plan, the Bicycle Program was formally established in 2012 to help make Calgary a bicycle-friendly community and provide Calgarians with more transportation choices.

The Bicycle Program operates within the Transportation department and aims to:


- Plan, design and build on-street bikeways.
- · Identify and remove barriers to cycling.
- · Educate and encourage cycling.
- Increase the supply of bicycle parking.
- Coordinate with other City departments and community organizations to improve cycling.












Top 15 cycling locations 2015 - 6 hour counts



About the 2015 bicycle count

In a continuing effort to understand Calgary's progress towards becoming a bicycle friendly community, The City's Transportation Department, through the Bicycle Program, conducted its first demographic bicycle count in 2013. The City aims to annually monitor changes and trends in cycling volumes and demographics at specific locations across Calgary. The results of the 2015 count have been analyzed and are presented in this report.

The Bicycle Count is only one of the ways the Bicycle Program is monitoring and evaluating cycling data.

The City also has automated counters that collect 24 hour bicycle volume data throughout the year for project monitoring and evaluation. Counters are typically installed along cycle tracks or regional pathways. Count information is available to the public, visit calgary.ca/bikedata to learn more.

How and where the data was collected

The data for the 2015 Bicycle Count was collected at 78 locations throughout Calgary, at the intersections of two bikeways or pathways and points where cyclists cross a bridge or underpass. The City added 7 new locations for the 2015 count, five of which were collected as part of the Centre City cycle track pilot project.


Figure 1. Handheld electronic counter

The data was manually collected by City data collectors using handheld electronic counters (Figure 1). The collection period was weekdays in May, June, July and September, between 6:30 to 9:30 a.m. and 3:30 to 6:30 p.m., which formed a six-hour count period. Weather and construction detours can cause fluctuation in bike trip volumes.

The Bicycle Count is intended to provide a snapshot of bicycle use in different locations over time and does not monitor all bicycle trips in Calgary. For more bicycle data and resource information, please see page 10.

The complete location index is available in Appendix A and 2015 data is available in Appendix B.

A comparison of the 78 locations counted in either 2013, 2014 or 2015 is provided in Appendix C.

Data collected included:

- · Number of cyclists.
- Age of cyclists (Under 18, 18 to 65, and over 65).
- · Gender of cyclists.
- Number of cyclists riding with or without helmets.
- People walking or using a wheelchair or mobility scooter (Appendix D).

General data collection results


Cycling volumes

27, 671 cyclists were counted at 78 locations in six-hour data collection time periods. The top three count locations were all on the Bow River Pathway between the west edge of downtown and Crowchild Trail S.W.

In the Centre City, 19 locations were counted and out of these, 11 Centre City locations recorded more than 500 cyclists in the six-hour data collection period. Over 46 per cent of all cyclists, 12,733 cyclists in total, were recorded at Centre City count locations.


Age

Under 18

- Approximately 2 per cent of all cyclists counted were under the age of 18.
- The largest total number of under 18 cyclists were observed at the Whitehorn pathway intersection N.E., with 36 cyclists under 18 years of age counted in a six-hour period. Under 18 cyclists made up 44 per cent of all cyclists at this location.
- The highest proportion of under 18 cyclists was found at the 42 Street and 13 Avenue S.W., with 46 per cent of all cyclists at that location under 18 years of age. In total, 13 cyclists under 18 years of age were counted at this location.

Top five cycling locations for under 18






Over 65

- Approximately 1 per cent of all cyclists counted were over the age of 65.
- The largest total number and the highest proportion of cyclists over 65 years of age was located at 13A Street and 8 Avenue N.E., with 19 cyclists over 65 years of age counted in a six-hour period. Cyclists over 65 years of age made up 13 per cent of all cyclists at this location.


Females

- On average, females comprised 24 per cent of all cyclists counted, this is an overall increase of 2 per cent from 2014 and 3 per cent from 2013.
- The highest proportion of female cyclists, 50 per cent, was observed at 20 Street and 42 Avenue S.W.
- Four locations had a higher proportion of female cyclists than the 2014 highest proportion location (which had 44 per cent observed at 29 Street N.W. at the Foothills Hospital path crossing 11 Avenue N.W.).
- The top three locations for female cyclists were recorded along the Bow River Pathway.
 525 female cyclists were counted at the top location on the Bow River Pathway at Crowchild Trail S.W.


Males

- 76 per cent of all cyclists counted were male.
- The highest number of male cyclists were counted at the Bow River Pathway at Crowchild Trail S.W., with 1,681 male cyclists.

Top female ridership locations by percentage of total riders Female cyclists




Top male ridership locations by percentage of total riders ■ Male cyclists





Helmet Use

Helmet use


84 per cent of cyclists counted wore helmets. At the original 50 count locations, helmet use changed from 86.1per cent in 2013 to 83.5 per cent in 2016. The highest proportion of cyclists observed wearing helmets was at Edworthy Street and Spruce Drive S.W. with 99.8 per cent of all cyclists wearing helmets. The lowest proportion of cyclists observed wearing helmets was at Dovercliffe Way S.E. (west of 41 Street S.E. at pathway trailhead) with 16.7 per cent of cyclists wearing helmets.

Pedestrians, wheelchairs and mobile scooters

In conjunction with the bicycle count, The City of Calgary also counted people walking or using a wheelchair or mobility scooter at each location. This information provides The City with an understanding of other users at each count location, which helps with planning projects and tracking trends over time. Data regarding age and gender of people walking or using a wheelchair or mobility scooter was not collected. In total, 66,617 pedestrians were counted and 48 wheelchair and mobile scooter users were counted.

The largest volumes of pedestrians (9,214) was counted at the intersection of the University LRT Bridge over Crowchild Trail N.W. The location counted with the fewest pedestrians (4) was the 52 Street S.E. Bridge and Canal pathway. The location with the greatest number of people using wheelchairs and mobile scooters (10) was Stephen Avenue (8 Avenue) just west of Centre Street S.W. For additional count data regarding people walking or using a wheelchair or mobility scooter see Appendix D.


