


Planning for the future of Shaganappi Trail

Connecting the South Shaganappi Study with the Shaganappi Trail North Corridor Study

- Shaganappi Trail, as an arterial street will accommodate all modes of transportation and provide a direct connection between multiple communities and key destinations.
- It is designated as a primary route for high-occupancy vehicles (HOV), transit and bikes in the 2009 Calgary Transportation Plan (CTP).
- The recommendations for the Shaganappi Trail North Corridor Study were approved by Council in 2015. These recommendations are illustrated below.
- The South Shaganappi Study will explore the future design for the south end of Shaganappi Trail.
- The outcome will be an integrated design that addresses issues today and plans for future transportation needs.
