List of Potential Improvements

The Parking Revenue Reinvestment Program provides funds to support vitality in business areas and communities with on-street paid parking. Reinvested revenues may be used for the following purposes within an applicable Business Improvement Area or Community Association:

• Mobility-related capital items, including:

- o Accessibility improvements
- Bicycle racks
- Bollards or gates
- Crosswalk and intersection treatments
- On-street parking configurations
- o Sidewalks
- Streetlights (e.g. decorative poles, pedestrian lighting)
- Traffic calming measures
- Transit Furniture (including shelters and benches)
- Way-finding infrastructure

• Public realm-related capital items, including:

- o Banners
- Experiential lighting programs (e.g. lighting of facades, features)
- o Fences
- Planters and flower baskets
- o Public Art
- o Retaining walls
- o Street Furniture
- Trees and tree grates
- Waste and recycling receptacles

• Enhanced annual operational services, including:

- o Boulevard maintenance, such as mowing or weed control
- Graffiti Abatement
- Planting of flowers
- Pressure washing
- Snow clearing and removal
- Street sweeping
- Waste collection
- Planning or studies facilitating any of the above objectives
- City of Calgary staff time to support implementation of the above

Note, additional initiatives not listed above may be proposed for consideration by The City of Calgary. All potential improvements need approval from The City of Calgary before implementation.
