



## 24 Street SE Storm Pond and Ogden Landfill Remediation

# NEWSLETTER

## DECEMBER 2020

### Project Background

The City of Calgary is building a new dry storm pond and completing the construction of an embankment that will be part of the corridor for the future Green Line LRT. The pond and embankment are being built on the west half of the former Ogden Dry Waste Management Facility. This is a complex project that requires 24/7 activity at the worksite. Most of the work is expected to be completed by the end of December 2020. Minor surface work will take place in the spring of 2021.

*Morgan Construction and Environmental Ltd.* is the prime contractor hired by The City to complete the project.

### What we did in November

November was a very productive month for the project. The weather was on the favourable side and we were able to make up for the time lost due to previous inclement weather. This is what we accomplished in the past month:

- ✓ Completed 100% of the future LRT embankment fill;
- ✓ Installed 95% of the pond underground utilities and structures;

- ✓ Completed about 90% of the pond floor;
- ✓ Removed the ground water treatment plant, so the flows being pumped from the ground no longer need treatment
- ✓ Removed all but one ground water sump

### What to expect in December

We'll continue to push forward while the weather allows to get closer to project completion. This month we expect to achieve the following:

- ✓ Complete underground utilities;
- ✓ Finish off the entire pond floor;
- ✓ Place subsoil and top soil layers ahead of final hydroseeding;
- ✓ Advance as much as possible with the site final restoration;
- ✓ Morgan will demobilize, and the site will be left secured.

By the end of the December the project will effectively be substantially completed, meaning the works built will be able to perform their intended purpose.

As the project enters in its final stage there will be noise, dust and lighting typical of construction of this nature. We will continue monitoring possible issues and take corrective actions to keep disturbances at reasonable levels.
