Project Background

The City of Calgary is building a new dry storm pond on the northwest end of the closed Ogden Dry Waste Landfill and completing the construction of an embankment adjacent to the storm pond which will be part of the corridor for the future Green Line LRT.

Morgan Construction and Environmental Ltd. is the prime contractor hired by The City to complete the project.

Most of the work took place from July to December 2020, with a pause in work from January to mid-April 2021. Landscaping and other minor works are planned to take place from mid-April until the end of June 2021. Morgan will work 7 days a week from 6:30 a.m. until 6:30 p.m.

What we did in 2020

- ✓ Morgan moved in all equipment, site office, and other site facilities. They took on the safety and environmental aspects of their operation;
- ✓ Completed clearing of the work site;
- ✓ Constructed a dewatering & treatment system;
- √ Relocated refuse to the Shepard landfill;
- ✓ Installed new components to the storm sewer including; a system to separate oil and sediment from runoff along 24 St. SE and part of the Riverbend community;
- ✓ Constructed the dry pond which includes a liner system below the surface plus a channel that connects the two inlets with a single outlet;
- ✓ Placed some of the topsoil, seed, and erosion control works;
- ✓ Demobilized equipment in December 2020

What to expect in 2021

Morgan and their subcontractors will be completing landscaping activities; planting shrubs and trees, placing stone edging, and completing topsoil and seed placement.

Other minor site works include commissioning the storm sewer system components, paving the pedestrian/maintenance pathway around the pond and the accesses at the north and south ends of the pond. New fencing will be placed along the east side of the pond and the fence on the west side of the pond along 24 St SE will be removed.

As these activities advance, there may be some construction noises and dust noticeable during the day. Provisions are put in place to keep noise, dust, and other disturbances at reasonable levels.
