



24 Street SE Storm Pond and Ogden Landfill Remediation

Project Background

The City of Calgary is building a new dry storm pond and completing the construction of an embankment that will be part of the corridor for the future Green Line LRT. The pond and embankment are being built on the west half of the former Ogden Dry Waste Management Facility. This is a complex project that requires 24/7 activity at the worksite. Most of the work is expected to be completed by the end of December 2020. Minor surface work will take place in the spring of 2021.

Morgan Construction and Environmental Ltd. is the prime contractor hired by The City to complete the project.

What we did in October



Working on the pond floor in sub-zero conditions

We experienced a setback in October due to the unexpected arrival of winter weather. Nonetheless, we didn't stop working and committed to continue despite the adverse conditions. This is what we accomplished this month:

- ✓ Continued pumping and treating ground water;
- ✓ Completed about 70% of the LRT embankment

- ✓ Completed the excavation for the pond;
- ✓ Manufactured pond fill materials on site to meet the technical requirements of the project,
- ✓ Imported to site fill materials not available on site;
- ✓ Hauled to the landfill the last loads of waste material from the;
- ✓ Built about 35% of the pond floor.

What to expect in November

- ✓ We'll take advantage of any day of good weather to continue working on the embankment. As such, we may resume 24-hour operation of the site;
- ✓ Embankment construction will advance as much as possible;
- ✓ Underground piping and structures for the pond will be installed;

As the project advances, there will be noise, dust and lighting typical of construction of this nature. We will continue monitoring possible issues and take corrective actions to keep disturbances at reasonable levels.
